



CRANE AND DERRICK TECHNICAL SUPERINTENDENT

The successful candidate will report to our Equipment and Yard Division Manager and be able to clearly prove that they have at a minimum, the following combination of experience and capabilities:

Key Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the company's crane operator training and competency evaluation program.
- Responsible for managing performance levels of all company equipment operators.
- Oversee the company's crane operator and deck engineer apprenticeship program.
- Assist in identifying risks when operating mobile equipment on project sites.
- Work with project crews in the development of safe operating procedures for cranes and mobile equipment for specific sites. This will include supporting FRPD estimators during the bidding process.
- Develop and maintain companywide procedures for the safe operations of mobile equipment and derrick fleet.
- Participate in company JHSC meeting.
- Chair the company crane safety meetings.
- Conduct site visits to ensure cranes and derricks are being properly maintained on site (housekeeping, safety supplies, general supplies).
- Liaise with operators and technical staff to ensure crane modification and upgrades to lifting equipment is meeting the regulatory requirements, company and operator's needs.
- Maintain open communication between maintenance staff and operators.
- Oversee the mobilization of cranes to ensure they are assembled as designed. This will include providing cost estimates for mobilization and approvals verifying the crane is safe to put in operations.
- Ensure compliance regarding equipment log books and company maintenance reporting sheets.
- Will be required to develop and review critical lift plans upon request.

Required Skills:

- Minimum 5-year experience operating a lattice boom crane in a marine construction environment.
- Experience working with a unionized labour force.
- Familiar with Work Safe Regulations and CSA Standards.
- Currently have or willing to obtain a Level 1 First Aid Certification (company will provide training).
- Self-starter and highly motivated.
- Computer skills are required using Word and Excel.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Demonstrated problem solving and decision making ability.

Qualifications:

- Minimum 5 years in a supervisory role.
- Must have a Red Seal Mobile Crane Operators Certificate.
- Most hold a valid driver's license.
