



## **Environment & Safety Technician**

### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL**

- Promote proactive environmental awareness for projects undertaken by FRPD.
- Support jobsites through regular environmental monitoring, including, but not limited to maintaining accurate records, water quality monitoring, sediment sampling, site audits and providing recommendations and reports as necessary.
- Assist with the environmental permitting process as necessary.
- Liaise regularly with the Regulatory Compliance & Environmental Manager in regards to jobsite performance, environmental issues and incidents.
- Aid in the inspection of any environmental incidents and ensure corrective action taken is appropriate and compliant.
- Participate in environmental programs and initiatives, such as the Climate Smart program.
- Other duties shall be assigned as required.

#### **SAFETY**

- Assist project staff to help resolve health and safety challenges.
- Perform safety inspections and develop clear action plans and monitor progress.
- Support development and training of safe work procedures.
- Research and define issues, the applicable legislation, and options for correction.
- Ensure safety data collected by the Health and Safety Team is managed to ensure quality and organization.
- Understand and apply company and client policies and procedures; industry practices & fundamental industry regulation; emergency response plans; specific job operations and equipment. Monitor emergency preparedness.
