- Food preparation.
- Requesting and supplying the Master with Food, Drink, and Sanitation store requisitions.
- General maintenance, repair, sanitation and upkeep of galley, mess room, and food storage area equipment.
- Using emergency, lifesaving, damage control, and safety equipment including firefighting equipment and launching of lifesaving equipment.
- Supervision of Steward, when not in Steward's role, and ensuring Steward carries out his/her work as required.
- Any other duties as assigned by the Master, Mate on Watch or Cook.

Qualifications:

- Cook's Certificate.
- Certificate of FOODSAFE Training.
- Transport Canada Marine Medical Certificate (or obtain within six months).
- MED with respect to STCW Basic Safety (or obtain within six months).

Working Conditions:

- The three week rotation will typically be one week Ship's Cook, one week Steward and one week off.
- 12 hour days with overtime as required.
- Unionized position.
